GENERAL REPORT.

One Mosquito XIX of 85 Squadron, Pilot F/Lt. Phillips, Navigator F/Lt. Smith, was airborne Swannington 0058 hours on 28th/29th September 1944, on High Level intruder to Varrelbusch Quackenbruck and Ahlhorn.

• F/Lt. Phillips reports:-

"At 0200 hours I was on my way to patrol at 11,500 ft. and had got as far as the Zoidlaarder Lake, approximately, when a "Monroe" contact was seen at 7,000 ft. behind and it closed to 3,000 ft. when I did a hard port turn. I did about two hard port orbits and contact was obtained about 90° to port and two miles away."

Contact was followed on an almost straight target doing about 250-260 m.p.h. at 10,500 ft. A visual was obtained and identified as a Ju.188 at 300 ft. by long pointed wings and square rudder. I opened fire at 200 ft. and enemy aircraft burst into flames and fell down to port and burst on hitting the ground. Position approximately Meppen area."

Claim: 1 Ju.188 destroyed.

Mosquito landed base at 0348 hours.
